

# 2016 Spare Time Latham Tournament Wrap-up

Tom Hankey of Great Barrington, MA defeated Hunter Kempton of Buzzard's Bay, MA 200 - 190 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Spare Time Latham on Saturday, September 24th.

The stepladder finals began with the fourth-seeded Kempton defeating third-seeded Jenna Lemke of Delmar 215 – 185. Lemke, who finished fourth overall, won a \$175 scholarship as the top finisher in the Girls Division. Kempton then converted the 2-10 split twice, including once in the ninth frame, to edge Andrew Bourgeois of Blossvale 215 – 211 and advance to the title match. Bourgeois earned a \$100 scholarship for finishing third.

In the championship match, Hankey began with a spare followed by three consecutive strikes to open up a 41-pin lead. Kempton was able to close to within 30 pins following the sixth frame. Hankey closed the match with spares in the ninth and tenth frames to win his second career title and a \$225 scholarship as the top finisher in the Boys Division. Kempton won a \$150 scholarship for his runner-up finish.

Hankey began his day with a 241 to take the early lead. Andrew Hall of Westborough, MA rolled a 264 in Game 2 to vault into the lead, where he would remain following Game 3 as well. Hankey then regained the lead by 20 pins heading into the semifinals. In the semifinals, Hankey rolled a 684 series and won all three of his matches to pull away from the field by 148 pins and earn the top seed for the finals. Bourgeois and Lemke also won all three of their semifinal matches to earn the second and third seeds, respectively. Kempton won his final two matches to become the fourth seed.

A field of 44 bowlers (27 boys and 17 girls) competed in our first tournament of our seventh season and earned \$1,160 in scholarships. Since our founding in May 2010, the total scholarships awarded in CDYST events have now surpassed \$100,000.

Additional scholarship winners in the Boys Division are as follows: Hall (\$75) in fourth place (fifth overall); Isaiah Days of Syracuse (\$50) in fifth (sixth overall); and Spencer Catlin of Diamond Point (\$35) in sixth (eighth overall). The remaining scholarship winners in the Girls Division are Lauren Piotrowski of Schenectady (\$100) in second place (seventh overall); Jessica Shufelt of Watervliet (\$70) in third (tenth overall); and Morgan Ruggeri of Johnstown (\$40) in fourth (15th overall).
