

2016 Del Lanes Tournament Wrap-up

Kenny Livengood of Ravena won three matches in the stepladder finals, including a 204 – 191 victory over Lauren Piotrowski of Schenectady to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Del Lanes on Saturday, October 8th.

The stepladder finals began with the third-seeded Livengood defeating fourth-seeded Garrett Bartlett of Troy 212 – 163. Bartlett, who finished fourth, won a \$100 scholarship as the third-place finisher in the Boys Division. Livengood then defeated second-seeded Andrew Hall of Westborough, MA 214 – 201 and advance to the title match. Hall, who finished third, earned a \$150 scholarship as the second-place finisher in the Boys Division.

In the championship match, both bowlers began with marks in the first three frames as Piotrowski had a two-pin lead. Livengood then rolled three consecutive strikes to take a 19-pin lead. Piotrowski closed to within seven pins; but Livengood converted a spare in the tenth frame to win his first career title and a \$225 scholarship as the top finisher in the Boys Division. Piotrowski, the runner-up, earned a \$200 scholarship as the top finisher in the Girls Division.

In the qualifying round, Robert Mengel of Albany was the leader after the first three games, as he compiled a 703 series. Livengood then closed with 506 in Games 3 and 4 to take the lead heading into the semifinals. Piotrowski closed her qualifying round by starting with ten consecutive strikes in rolling a 284 to move into second place. She then won her first semifinal match to move into the lead; and followed with two more victories to earn the top seed for the finals. Hall rolled a 666 three-game series and won one semifinal match to earn the second seed. Livengood powered his way into the finals by rolling a 265 in his final match victory to vault from 13th place after six games into the third seed. Bartlett rounded out the top four by winning his final two matches.

A field of 49 bowlers (28 boys and 21 girls) competed in our second tournament of the season and earned \$1,255 in scholarships. This brings our season total to \$2,415.

Additional scholarship winners in the Boys Division are as follows: Jared Taylor of Selkirk (\$75) in fourth place (fifth overall); Christian Chiarito of Schenectady (\$50) in fifth (sixth overall); and Alex Alesio of Schenectady (\$35) in sixth (seventh overall). The remaining scholarship winners in the Girls Division are Jada Bassette of Providence, RI (\$125) in second place (ninth overall); Melanie Lemke of Delmar (\$75) in third (tied for twelfth overall); Mariah Williams of Bloomington (\$50) in fourth (14th overall); and Katie Lynch of Troy (\$50) in fifth (17th overall).

Our next tournament will begin at 1:00 pm on Saturday October 29, 2016 at Broadway Lanes in Fort Edward. It will also offer optional Junior Gold qualifying for all CDYST members. Bowlers may purchase their membership that day and still try and qualify.
