



## December 2016 Imperial Lanes Tournament Wrap-up

Haley Youker of Minoa defeated Billy McGaffin of Amsterdam 171 – 160 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Imperial Lanes on Saturday, December 10th.

The stepladder finals began with third-seeded McGaffin defeating fourth-seeded Andrew Hall of Westborough, MA 211 - 133. Hall finished fourth overall and won a \$150 scholarship as the second place finisher in the Boys Division. McGaffin then defeated the second-seeded Jenna Lemke of Delmar 199 - 177 to set up the title match. Lemke finished third overall and earned a \$125 scholarship as the second place finisher in the Girls Division.

In a title match between the only two bowlers to hold the lead throughout the event, McGaffin began with a strike and two spares to take a 22-pin lead. With McGaffin's lead at 19 pins through five frames, Youker rolled three consecutive strikes to erase her deficit and open a 12-pin lead. She maintained her lead to win her first CDYST title and a \$225 scholarship as the top finisher in the Girls Division. The runner-up McGaffin won a \$250 scholarship as the top finisher in the Boys Division.

Competing in a six-game qualifying round on the USBC sport-compliant PBA Chameleon lane condition, McGaffin began with a 269 to jump out to the lead. He continued to extend his lead over the next four games and would be the top qualifier heading into the semifinals. Youker began her day in 25th place following the first two games. However, she closed with 932 over her final four games to vault into second place and within 67 pins of the lead. Youker began the semifinals with a victory over McGaffin to take the lead by 5 pins. She won one of her final two matches to pull away from the field and earn the top seed for the finals. Lemke, who was sixth after qualifying, won all three of her semifinal matches to earn the second seed for the finals. McGaffin won one match to earn the third seed. Hall tied a match and had one victory to finish in a fourth place tie with Robert Mengel of Albany, who won two of his three semifinal matches. Hall defeated Mengel 37 – 29 in a two-frame roll-off to become the fourth seed.

A total of 51 bowlers (29 boys and 22 girls) competed in the fifth tournament of the season. Additional scholarship winners in the Boys Division are Mengel (\$100) in third place (fifth overall); Christian Osterhoudt of Ulster Park (\$75) in fourth (sixth overall); Michael Boyce of Gansevoort (\$50) in fifth (seventh overall); and Kyair Sylvester of Albany (\$40) in sixth (eighth overall). The remaining scholarship winners in the Girls Division are Jordan Byrnes of Kinderhook (\$75) in third place (12th overall); Jessica Shufelt of Watervliet (\$50) in fourth (13th overall); and Melanie Lemke of Delmar (\$40) in fifth (15th overall). Our talented youth bowlers earned \$1,310 in scholarships; bringing the season total to \$5,905.

Boyce, Osterhoudt, Youker, Jenna Lemke, Christian Baitinger of Greenfield Center, and Morgan Ruggeri of Johnstown earned entries into the 2017 USBC Junior Gold Championships in Cleveland.

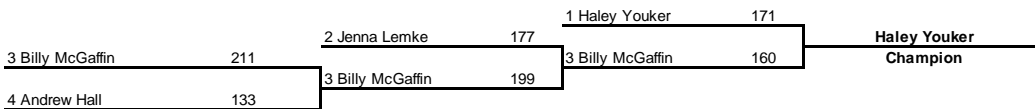
