



## **February 2017 Kingpin's Alley Tournament Wrap-up**

Jenna Lemke of Delmar won three matches in the stepladder finals; including a 179 – 169 victory over Tom Hankey of Great Barrington, MA to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Kingpin's Alley on Saturday, February 25th.

The stepladder finals began with fourth-seeded Lemke defeating third-seeded Billy McGaffin of Amsterdam 209 – 145. The fourth place finisher McGaffin earned a \$100 scholarship for finishing third in the Boys Division. Lemke then defeated the second-seeded Andrew Marotta of Ballston Spa 219 – 202 to set up the title match. The third place finisher Marotta won a \$150 scholarship for finishing second in the Boys Division.

In a title match indicative of the grueling lane conditions faced throughout the day, Hankey began with a spare and two strikes to take an 11-pin lead that he was able to retain through six frames. Lemke alternated strikes and spares from the sixth through ninth frames to close the gap; and converted the 2-4-8 spare in the tenth frame to earn her second title of the season and a \$150 scholarship as the top finisher in the Girls Division. The runner-up Hankey earned a \$225 scholarship as the top finisher in the Boys Division.

Competing in a six-game qualifying round on the USBC sport-compliant, 2012 Asian Bowling Federation Championship tournament pattern; Kyair Sylvester of Albany was the leader after Game 1. Brandon Wolf of Schenectady vaulted ahead after rolling a 249, the highest game of the day, in Game 2; before Hankey moved ahead after Game 3. Wolf returned to the top spot after Game 4 and would retain the lead heading into the semifinals. In the semifinals, Hankey won all three of his matches to earn the top seed for the finals. Marotta won two of his three matches to become the second seed; while McGaffin was undefeated in earning the third seed. Lemke had split her first two matches and was in seventh place before winning her final match to surge into the finals as the fourth seed.

A total of 45 bowlers (31 boys and 14 girls) competed in the eleventh tournament of the season. The remaining scholarship winners in the Boys Division are Spencer Catlin of Diamond Point (\$75) in fourth place (fifth overall); Michael Boyce of Gansevoort (\$50) in fifth (sixth overall); Alex Alesio of Schenectady (\$45) in sixth (seventh overall); and Hunter Kempton of Buzzards Bay (\$40) in seventh (ninth overall). The remaining scholarship winners in the Girls Division are Morgan Ruggeri of Johnstown (\$100) in second place (eighth overall) and Jordan Byrnes of Kinderhook (\$50) in third (eleventh overall). Our talented youth bowlers earned \$1,120 in scholarships; bringing the season total to \$14,990.

Christopher Kokes of Mooers, Kasey Kosier of East Greenbush, and Willis Bickford of Fort Edward earned entries into the 2017 USBC Junior Gold Championships to be held in Cleveland.
