



## 2017 Del Lanes Tournament Wrap-up

Tom Hankey of Great Barrington, MA defeated Jahliil Young of Albany 236 – 167 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Del Lanes on Saturday, November 18th.

The stepladder finals began with third-seeded Nate Purches of Marlboro, MA (U15 Boys) rolling ten consecutive strikes to defeat Andrew Kopec of Auburn (U20 Boys) 278 - 202. Kopec earned \$55 in scholarships for finishing third in the Under-20 Boys Division and fourth overall. The second seeded Young (U20 Boys) then defeated Purches 185 – 155 to set up the title match. Purches won \$90 in scholarships for finishing first in the Under-15 Boys Division and third overall.

In the title match, the top-seeded Hankey (U20 Boys) followed a strike and spare with five consecutive strikes to open up a 68-pin lead and cruise to his second title of the season (sixth career) and \$210 in scholarships for finishing first in the Under-20 Boys Division and overall. Young won \$115 in scholarships for finishing second in the Under-20 Boys Division and the runner-up overall.

In the Qualifying Round, Hankey jumped out to the early lead following Game 1. Brandon Wolf of Schenectady edged ahead after Game 2 before Hankey retook the lead in Game 3 and would retain it heading into the semifinals. Hankey won his three semifinal matches to earn the top seed for the finals. Young, who was ninth after qualifying, rolled 713 and won two of his three matches to vault into second place. Kopec and Purches each won two matches to earn the third and fourth seeds, respectively.

In the Under-12 division, which was contested concurrent with the Qualifying Round, Matthew Rogers topped the field of three to become the winner and earn a \$45 scholarship.

A total of 36 bowlers (15 U20 Boys, 10 U20 Girls, 4 U15 Boys, 4 U15 Girls, and 3 U12) competed in the fourth tournament of the season. In the Under-20 Girls Division, Jenna Lemke of Delmar earned a \$110 scholarship for finishing first (sixth overall); and Mariah Williams of Bloomington won a \$50 scholarship for finishing second (eighth overall). Kathryn Bowman of Peru finished first in the Under-15 Girls Division (12th overall) and earned a \$65 scholarship. Our talented youth bowlers earned \$740 in scholarships; bringing the season total to \$3,150.

Our next tournament will begin at 1:00 pm on Saturday December 9th at Imperial Lanes in Amsterdam. 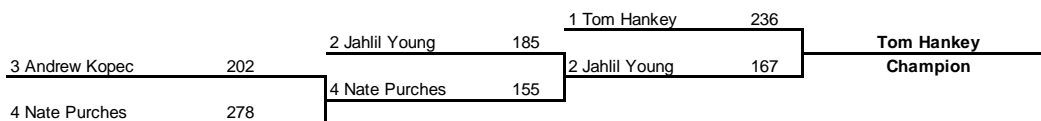
