2012 CDYST Masters Tournament Wrap-up

Michael Hartmann of Earlton went 5 – 1 in the match play finals, including a 226 – 197 Championship Round victory over Matthew Olson of Schenectady, to win the CDYST Masters tournament held on Saturday, April 28th at Town 'n Country Lanes.

The top 16 bowlers after a six-game qualifying round competed in single-game matches with a double-elimination format. In Round 5, Lawrence Lang of Rhinebeck defeated Joe Smith of Watervliet 199 – 178 and Olson defeated Corey Buckley of Albany 217 – 168. Smith and Buckley earned \$140 scholarships for finishing fourth and fifth, respectively. Olson then defeated Lang 217 – 181 to set up the Championship Round. Lang earned a \$250 scholarship for his third place finish.

Hartmann was the sole remaining undefeated bowler and therefore had to win only one game in the Championship Round to claim the title. Olson began the first game with seven strikes in the first eight frames to defeat Hartmann 231 – 218 and force a second game to determine the champion. Olson, who was on a six-match winning streak, rolled strikes in the third and fourth frames to take a two-pin lead through five frames. Hartmann responded with five strikes in a row to take the lead and pull away for his second CDYST title and an \$800 scholarship. Olson won a \$450 scholarship for his runner-up finish.

Hartmann earned an additional \$100 for leading the qualifying round with a 1234 series. Smith won an additional \$50 for being the second highest qualifier. Smith and Zachary Doty of Nassau earned berths into the USBC Junior Gold national tournament in Indianapolis from July 14 – 20, 2012.

The invitational CDYST Masters was the culmination of an outstanding second season; 23 bowlers competed for a prize fund of \$2,465 and the top 12 earned scholarships of at least \$50. Throughout the season, our talented youth bowlers earned \$10,925 in scholarships.

Olson's second place finish enabled him to win a tight race for the 2011 – 2012 Bowler of the Year by 15 points over Hartmann; 2010 – 2011 Bowler of the Year Christopher Hanson of Ballston Lake finished third. For their season-long performance, these bowlers earned entries into the Bowlers of Eastern Scholarship Tours tournament in Maple Shade, New Jersey on June 16 – 17, 2012.

The CDYST is now on hiatus through the summer, with the third season to start in the early fall. The schedule will be available later this summer. 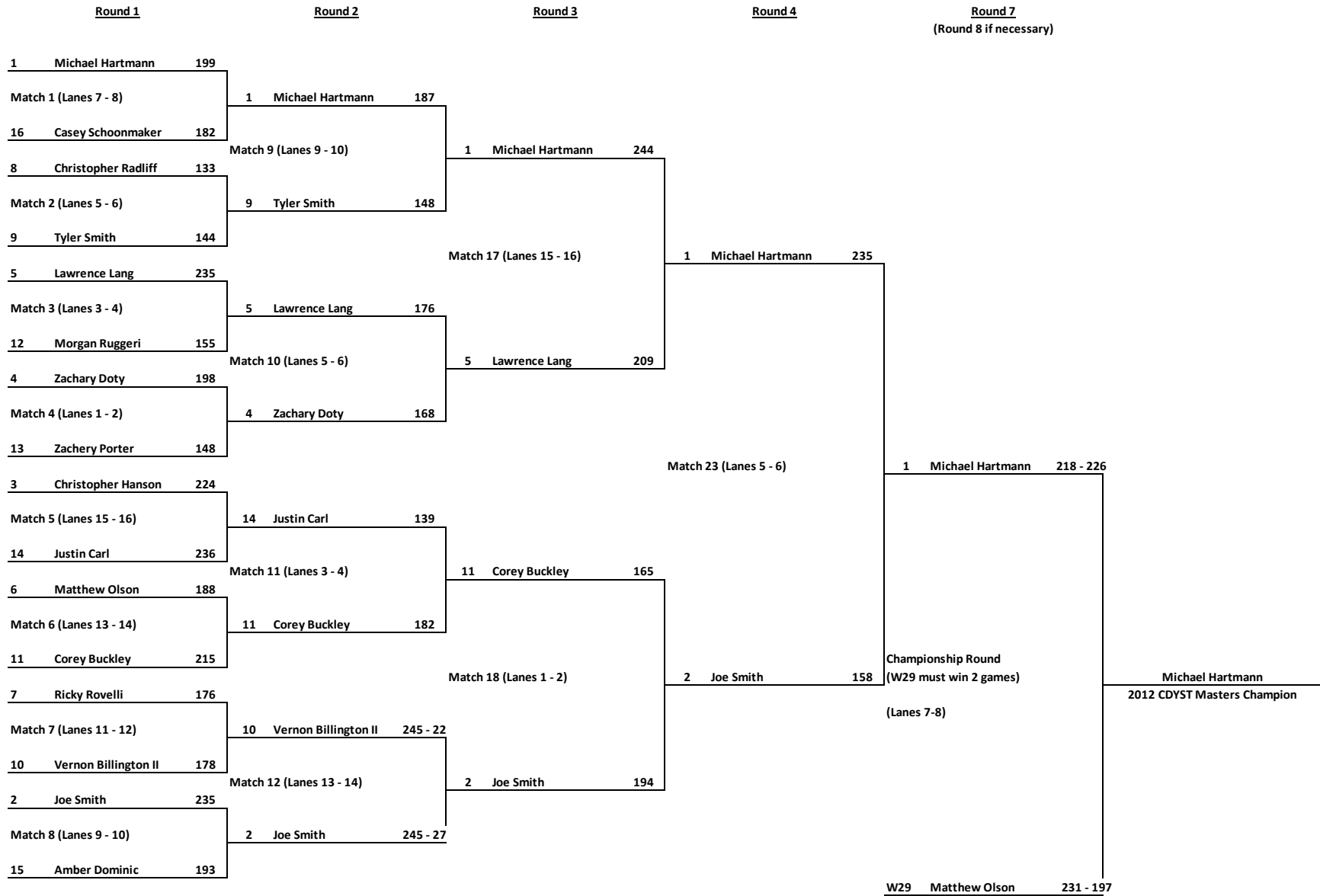

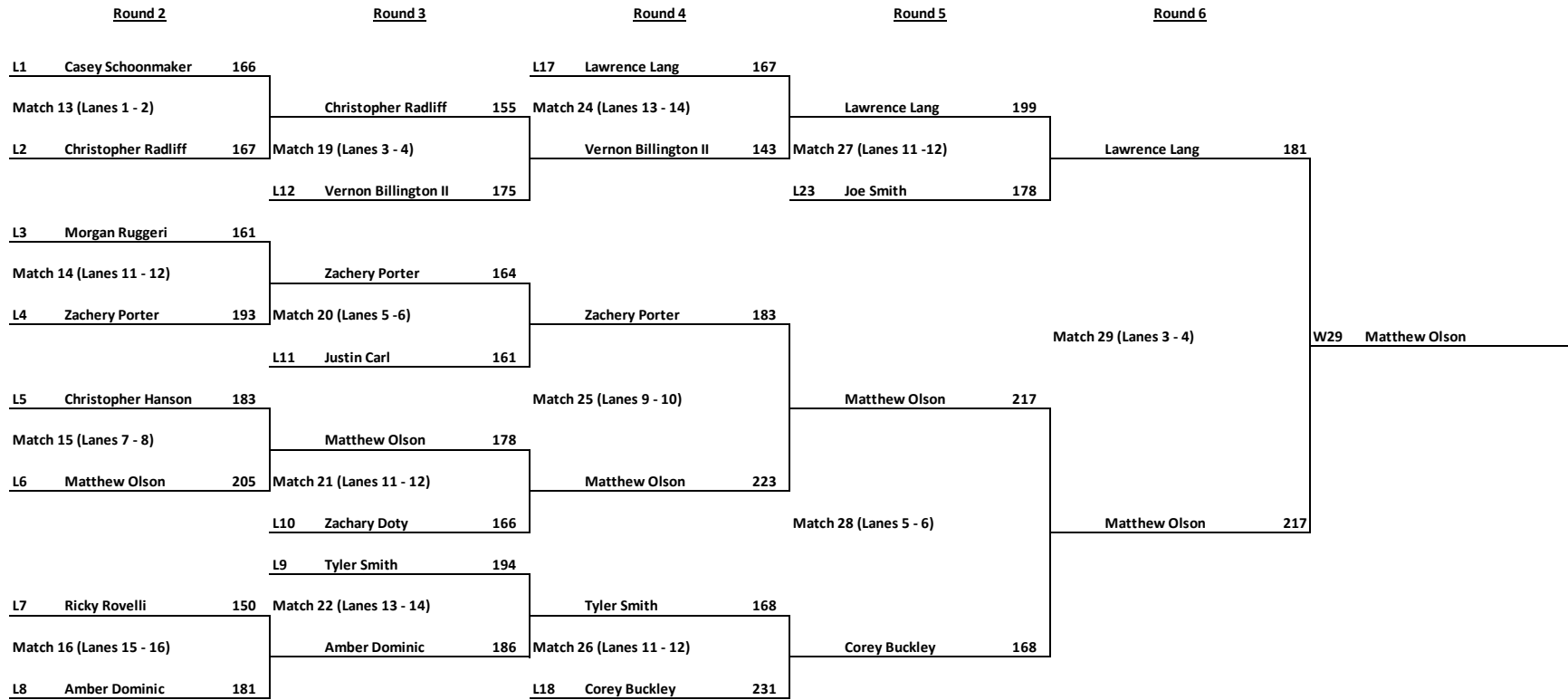
