

2014 Alpha Lanes Tournament Wrap-up

Ricky Rovelli of Albany defeated tournament leader Justin Carl of Albany 50 – 28 in a two-frame rolloff – after both bowlers tied at 204 – to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Alpha Lanes on Saturday, January 4th.

The stepladder finals began with the third-seeded Chad Sutliff of Valatie defeating fourth-seeded Jonathan Bowman of Peru 203 – 188. Bowman earned a \$90 scholarship prize for finishing fourth. The second-seeded Rovelli then rolled the first eight strikes in defeating Sutliff 265 - 203 to set up the title match. Sutliff earned a \$125 scholarship for finishing third.

In the title match, Rovelli rolled strikes in the second and third frames as he jumped out to a 24-pin lead through four frames. Carl responded with strikes in the fifth through seventh frames to close the gap to five pins. After Rovelli finished his game first, Carl converted a spare in the tenth frame and followed with a strike to tie the match and force the two-frame rolloff. Rovelli began the tiebreaker with a spare and followed it with three strikes to surge to his second CDYST title of the season and a \$300 scholarship. The victory was also his record fifth career title. Carl earned a \$175 scholarship for his runner-up finish.

Rovelli rolled a 900 four-game series in the qualifying round to be the leader heading into the semifinals. Bowman defeated Rovelli in their first semifinal match to take the lead. However, a victory by Rovelli in his second match allowed him to move back into first place. Carl then rolled a 268, the highest game of the day, in his final match to edge Rovelli by one pin to become the tournament leader heading into the finals.

There were 45 entries in the seventh tournament of the 2013 – 2014 season. Patrick DeVoe of Delmar earned a \$60 scholarship for finishing fifth; Corey Buckley of Albany won a \$50 scholarship for finishing sixth; Kyle Peck of Antwerp won a \$40 scholarship for finishing seventh; Natasha Bidwell of Schenectady finished eighth, but could not claim her scholarship prize because of NCAA regulations; Michael Hartmann of Earlton and Casey Schoonmaker of Albany won \$30 scholarships for finishing ninth and tenth, respectively. A total of \$1,045 in scholarships was awarded to our talented youth bowlers, bringing the season total to nearly \$8,500.

Our next tournament will be held at 1:00 pm on Saturday, January 25th at Imperial Lanes in Amsterdam. It will also offer optional Junior Gold qualifying for all current CDYST members who competed in at least two tournaments this season.
