2016 Barbecue Recreation Tournament Wrap-up

Zack Terry of Schenectady defeated Billy McGaffin of Amsterdam 205 – 200 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Barbecue Recreation on Sunday, March 20th.

The stepladder finals began with the third-seeded Justin Carl of Albany defeating fourth-seeded Brandon Wolf of Schenectady 215 – 192. Wolf won a \$75 scholarship for finishing fourth. The second-seeded McGaffin then closed with four consecutive strikes to edge Carl 213 – 211 and advance to the title match. Carl earned a \$100 scholarship for finishing third.

In the championship match, both bowlers began with two strikes in the first three frames; but Terry held a one-pin lead. He extended the lead to 13 pins after five frames. McGaffin then rolled strikes in the sixth through eighth frames to close to within two pins. Needing a mark in the tenth frame for the victory, Terry rolled a strike on his first ball win his third career title (third of the season) and a \$300 scholarship. McGaffin won a \$175 scholarship for his runner-up finish.

The tournament format had each bowler roll four games; with the top four bowlers advancing to a stepladder finals that was taped for broadcast on the April 3rd episode of the Huck Finn's Capital Region Bowling Show. Wolf began with 256 to take the early lead. Terry then rolled a 256 in Game 2 to rise from tenth place and into the lead. He closed with games of 200 and 247 to pull away and earn the top seed by 50 pins with a 909 series. McGaffin rolled a 267, the highest game of the day, in Game 2 to vault from 25th into fourth place. Closing games of 198 and 227 enabled him to earn the second seed. Carl rolled 235 and 216 in his final two games to rise from ninth place and become the third seed. Wolf closed with a 202 to rise from sixth place after three games and edge Christopher Kokes of Mooers by five pins for the final spot on the telecast.

A field of 35 bowlers competed in our twelfth tournament of the season and earned \$895 in scholarships; bringing the season total to \$16,120. Additional scholarship winners are as follows: Kokes (\$50) in fifth place; Jonathan Bowman of Peru (\$30) in sixth; and Dominick Favata of Niskayuna (\$25) in seventh.

Our next tournament will begin at 1:00 pm on Saturday April 9, 2016 at East Greenbush Bowling Center. It is our final open tournament of the season and it will also offer optional Junior Gold qualifying for any 2015 – 2016 CDYST members who have competed in at least three prior tournaments this season.
