2013 Burnt Hills Lanes Tournament Wrap-up

Zachery Porter of Schenectady led nearly wire-to-wire and defeated Austin Van Buren of Altamont 231 – 192 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Burnt Hills Lanes on Saturday, January 26th.

The stepladder finals began with the third-seeded Van Buren defeating fourth-seeded Christopher Hanson of Ballston Lake 252 – 186. Hanson earned a \$75 scholarship for finishing fourth. Van Buren then defeated second-seeded Chad Sutliff of Valatie 214 – 163 and set up the title match. Sutliff earned a \$110 scholarship for finishing third.

Van Buren began the championship match with three strikes in the first four frames to take a 25-pin lead. However, as he had throughout the entire day, Porter got himself lined up and rolled the next six strikes to erase the deficit and pull away to win his first CDYST title and a \$275 scholarship. Van Buren earned a \$175 scholarship for finishing second.

In the extended six-game qualifying round, Hanson led after Game 1. Porter rolled a 263 in Game 2 to take a lead that he would not relinquish for the rest of the day. His 1,395 total in the qualifying round gave him a 138-pin lead. He posted a 2 – 1 semifinal match play record to extend his lead to 157 pins. Sutliff went 3 – 0 and rolled a 690 series to rise from eighth and earn the second seed. Van Buren and Hanson performed steadily throughout the day to round out the top four heading to the finals.

In the seventh of ten 2012 – 2013 regular season tournaments there were 30 entries. Vernon Billington II of Hartford, CT finished in fifth place and earned a \$50 scholarship; Jonathan Bowman of Peru won a \$40 scholarship for finishing sixth; and Eli Burham of Kingston earned a \$35 scholarship for finishing seventh. Our talented youth bowlers earned \$855 in scholarships, bringing the season total to \$9,278. Billington II and Amber Dominic of Latham earned entries into the 2013 USBC Junior Gold tournament to be held from July 13 – 19, 2013 in Detroit.
