

2011 Catskill Lanes Tournament Wrap-up

Justin Carl of Albany won three matches in the stepladder finals, including a 236 - 183 victory over tournament leader Anthony Alix of Watervliet to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Catskill Lanes on Saturday, November 5th.

The stepladder finals began with the third-seeded Carl defeating fourth-seeded Christopher Hanson of Ballston Lake 228 - 221. Hanson earned a \$50 scholarship for finishing fourth. Carl then defeated second-seeded Matthew Olson of Schenectady 223 - 215 to set up the title match. Olson earned a \$70 scholarship for finishing third.

In the championship match, Alix jumped out to a 12-pin lead after two frames. However, Carl rolled strikes in seven of the next eight frames to take control of the match and win his first CDYST title and a \$175 scholarship. Alix earned a \$100 scholarship for his second place finish.

In a tournament marked by several high scores, Alix rolled the first 300 game in CDYST competition in Game 2. His 4-game series of 1008 during the qualifying round set a new record. Hanson was nearly perfect in Game 3; finishing with 288 after rolling the first ten strikes. Carl started the day slowly; he was 16th after Game 1 and 9th after Game 3. A steady performance over the next four games, including a 3 – 0 record in the semifinals, enabled him to earn the third seed for the finals.

In the third of ten tournaments in the 2011 – 2012 season, there were 26 entries. Eli Burham of Kingston earned a \$35 scholarship for finishing fifth and Corey Buckley of Albany won a \$30 scholarship for finishing sixth. A total of \$555 in scholarships was awarded to our talented youth bowlers, bringing the season total to \$1,565.

Our next tournament will be held at 1:30 pm on Saturday, November 19th at Sportsman's Bowl in Schenectady. Bowlers who have competed in at least one tournament during 2011 - 2012 season or were members during the 2010 – 2011 season will have the opportunity to qualify for Junior Gold.
