



2012 Del Lanes Tournament Wrap-up

Zachary Doty of Nassau defeated tournament leader Michael Hartmann of Earlton 244 - 237 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Del Lanes on Saturday, December 1st.

The stepladder finals began with the fourth-seeded Qwadaris Rembert of Providence, RI defeating third-seeded Jonathan Bowman of Peru, NY 236 - 178. Bowman earned a \$100 scholarship for finishing fourth. The second-seeded Doty then rolled eight consecutive strikes to defeat Rembert 269 - 211 and set up the title match. Rembert earned a \$150 scholarship for finishing third.

In the championship match, Doty rolled the first four strikes to jump out to a 42-pin lead. Following two spares, he rolled strikes in the seventh, eighth, and ninth frames, then closed with a spare to hold off the hard-charging Hartmann, who rolled the last seven strikes and was attempting to defend his title won at Del Lanes last season. Doty earned a \$325 scholarship for winning his first CDYST title and Hartmann won a \$200 scholarship for his second place finish.

In the qualifying round, Hartmann jumped out to the early lead before being overtaken in Game 4 by Bowman, who rolled a 900 four-game series. Casey Schoonmaker of Albany provided the highlight of the round when he rolled the third 300 game in CDYST competition in Game 3. In the semifinals, Rembert and Bowman were the respective leaders after Games 5 and 6. However, in Game 7, Hartmann and Doty won their matches and rolled 256 and 247, respectively to earn the top two seeds for the finals.

A record 49 bowlers competed in the fourth of ten 2012 - 2013 regular season tournaments. Tyler Bartee of Windsor, CT earned a \$75 scholarship for finishing fifth; Jadee Scott-Jones of East Providence, RI won a \$50 scholarship for finishing sixth; Gazmine Mason of Cranston, RI won a \$40 scholarship for finishing seventh; Taylor LeClair of West Coxsackie and Katy Barnes of East Greenwich, RI earned \$35 scholarships for finishing eighth and ninth, respectively; Bryan Bourget of Woonsocket, RI and Schoonmaker each won a \$30 scholarships for finishing tenth and eleventh, respectively. A regular season tournament record \$1,205 in scholarships was awarded to our talented youth bowlers, bringing the season total to \$4,185.

The next tournament will be held at 1:30 pm on Saturday, December 15th at Sportsman's Bowl. This event will offer an extended qualifying round and optional Junior Gold qualifying for all CDYST members who have competed in at least one prior tournament during the 2012 - 2013 season.
