

2014 Del Lanes Tournament Wrap-up

Jonathan Bowman of Peru defeated tournament leader Zachery Porter of Schenectady 197 – 155 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Del Lanes on Saturday, October 18th.

The stepladder finals began with fourth-seeded Kevin Benedetto of Albany defeating third-seeded Christopher Hanson of Ballston Lake 178 – 153. Hanson earned a \$75 scholarship for finishing fourth in the Boys Division. The second-seeded Bowman then defeated Benedetto 225 – 187 to set up the title match. Benedetto earned a \$100 scholarship for finishing third in the Boys Division.

Bowman began the title match with three consecutive strikes to take a 32-pin lead. Porter responded with strikes in the fifth and sixth frames to close to within 18 pins. Bowman then rolled strikes in the seventh and eighth frames to pull away and earn his fifth CDYST title and a \$275 scholarship as the top finisher in the Boys Division. Porter earned a \$175 scholarship for his runner-up finish.

In the qualifying round, Rebecca LaBelle of Pattersonville was the leader after Game 1. Bowman rolled 692 over the final three games to take the lead following Game 2 and be the top qualifier heading into the semifinals. Porter began the semifinals with the first nine strikes in rolling a 278 to surge into the lead; he followed with a 247 for a second consecutive victory to pull away and earn the top seed heading into the finals. Three strong games and one victory enabled Bowman to be the second seed. Hanson and Benedetto each won all three of their semifinal matches to earn the third and fourth seeds, respectively.

There were 56 entries in the second tournament of the 2014 – 2015 season; 40 in the Boys Division and 16 in the Girls Division. Additional scholarship winners in the Boys Division included: Peter Konrad of Schenectady (\$50) in fifth place; Billy McGaffin of Amsterdam (\$40) in sixth; Charles Moeske of Schenectady (\$35) in seventh; and Justin Carl of Albany (\$30) in eighth. Scholarship winners in the Girls Division are as follows: Kasey Kosier of East Greenbush (\$150) for finishing first (10th overall); Janelle Irwin of Schenectady (\$90) in second (13th overall); Jordan Byrnes of Kinderhook (\$50) in third (16th overall); and Melanie Lemke of Delmar (\$30) in fourth (21st overall). A total of \$1,240 in scholarships was awarded to our talented youth bowlers, bringing the season total to \$2,285.

Our next tournament will begin at 1:30 pm on Saturday, November 8th at Sportsmans Bowl in Schenectady. It will also offer optional Junior Gold qualifying to any youth bowler who is currently a CDYST member or purchases their membership on site. 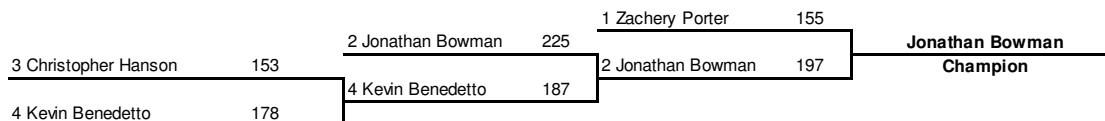
