

2015 Del Lanes Tournament Wrap-up

Christopher Radliff of Schenectady won three matches in the stepladder finals; including a 246 – 216 victory over tournament leader Jenna Lemke of Delmar to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Del Lanes on Saturday, November 7th.

The stepladder finals began with the third-seeded Radliff rolling nine strikes in his first ten frames to defeat fourth-seeded Lauren Piotrowski of Schenectady 268 – 230. Piotrowski won a \$90 scholarship for finishing second in the Girls Division (fourth overall). Radliff then defeated the second-seeded Andrew Hall of Westborough, MA 227 – 187 to advance to the title match. Hall earned a \$150 scholarship for finishing second in the Boys Division (third overall).

In the championship match, Lemke began with four strikes in her first five frames to open up an 11-pin lead. Radliff responded by rolling five strikes in a row from the sixth through tenth frames to pull away and earn his first career title and a \$225 scholarship as the top finisher in the Boys Division. Lemke won a \$150 scholarship as the runner-up and top finisher in the Girls Division.

In the qualifying round, Hall was the leader following Game 1. Radliff then took the lead following Game 2 and would remain on top after Game 3. Amanda Chrzanowski of Schenectady rolled a 243 in her final game to surge into the lead heading into the semifinals. Lemke, who was second after qualifying, rolled a 673 three-game series and won all of her matches to earn the top seed for the finals. Hall won two of his three matches to become the second seed. Radliff won his final two matches, including a 246 game in his final match that enabled him to move from fifth place into third. Piotrowski rolled 30 clean frames in the semifinals to win her three matches and rise from sixth place following qualifying and earn the fourth seed.

A field of 48 bowlers (32 boys and 16 girls) competed in our third tournament of the season and earned \$1,115 in scholarships; bringing the season total to \$3,405.

Additional scholarship winners in the Boys Division are as follows: Garrett Bartlett of Troy (\$100) in third place (fifth overall); Hunter Kempton of Buzzard's Bay, MA (\$75) in fourth (sixth overall); Michael Boyce of Schuylerville (\$50) in fifth (eighth overall); Kevin Benedetto of Albany (\$40) in sixth (ninth overall); and Tom Hankey of Great Barrington, MA (\$35) in seventh (tenth overall). Additional scholarship winners in the Girls Division scholarship winners are Chrzanowski (\$60) in third place (seventh overall) and Katie Lynch of Troy (\$35) in fourth (13th overall).
