

2014 East Greenbush Bowling Center Tournament Wrap-up

Patrick DeVoe of Delmar defeated Jonathan Bowman of Peru 224 - 192 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at East Greenbush Bowling Center on Saturday, April 12th.

The stepladder finals began with fourth-seeded Casey Schoonmaker of Albany defeating third-seeded Morgan Ruggeri of Johnstown 204 - 142. Ruggeri earned a \$75 scholarship for finishing fourth. The second-seeded DeVoe then rolled a late triple to edge Schoonmaker 242 - 233 and set up the title match. Schoonmaker earned a \$100 scholarship for finishing third.

Following two spares to begin the championship match, Bowman rolled three strikes in a row to open up a 31-pin lead. However, DeVoe responded with seven strikes in the final eight frames to surge to his second CDYST title and a \$275 scholarship. Bowman earned a \$150 scholarship for his runner-up finish.

In the qualifying round, Bowman took the lead after the first game and pulled away, expanding it to 123 pins heading into the semifinal round. A victory in his first semifinal match provided the margin that enabled him to withstand charges from the other three finalists and earn the top seed. DeVoe won two of his semifinal matches to earn the second seed, while Ruggeri rolled a 668 three-game series to be the high scorer and win all three of her matches to vault from ninth place into third. Schoonmaker rolled 243 to win his final match and earn the fourth seed.

There were 35 entries in the twelfth tournament of the 2013 - 2014 season. Additional scholarship winners included Jacob Rivers Jr. of Albany for finishing fifth (\$50); Chad Sutliff for finishing sixth (\$40); and Andrew Bennett of Albany for finishing seventh (\$30). A total of \$840 in scholarships was awarded to our talented youth bowlers, bringing the season total to \$13,550.

This was the final open event of the season. Our season wraps up with two invitational tournaments that will offer optional Junior Gold qualifying. The first is open to all 2013 - 2014 CDYST members and will begin at 9:30 am on Saturday April 26th at Hi-Way Recreation in Wynantskill. Paid reservations are strongly recommended since the field will be capped at 60 bowlers. The final tournament will be the 2014 CDYST Masters, presented by Columbia 300, Ebonite, Hammer, and Track. It will start at 9:30 am on Saturday May 10th at Town 'n Country Lanes in Guilderland. Only members who have competed in at least four tournaments during the season will be eligible.

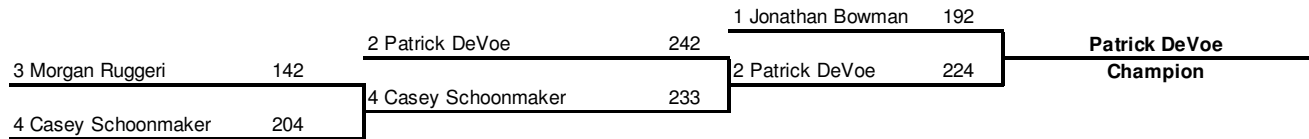
