2013 Hometown Lanes Tournament Wrap-up

Ricky Rovelli of Albany defeated tournament leader Austin Van Buren of Altamont 206 – 203 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Hometown Lanes on Saturday, November 9th.

The stepladder finals began with fourth-seeded Casey Schoonmaker of Albany defeating third-seeded Patrick DeVoe of Delmar 233 – 189. DeVoe earned a \$90 scholarship for finishing fourth. The second-seeded Rovelli then converted the 10-pin on his final ball to edge Schoonmaker 223 – 222 and set up the title match. Schoonmaker earned a \$125 scholarship for finishing third.

In a very close title match that saw both bowlers roll clean games, Rovelli took an early nine-pin lead after strikes in the third and fourth frames. Each bowler alternated strikes and spares until Van Buren rolled strikes in the eighth and ninth frames to tie the match. After Van Buren filled 17 pins in the tenth frame, Rovelli stepped up and rolled a strike and a spare to earn his CDYST record fourth title and a \$300 scholarship. Van Buren won a \$175 scholarship for his runner-up finish.

Van Buren began the qualifying round with a 288 game in route to establishing a new CDYST four-game record of 1,031. He won two semifinal matches as he compiled the highest seven-game series in CDYST history, with 1,728 (1,788 with bonus). Rovelli got off to a slow start in qualifying, as he was in 25th place after two games. He then rolled 496 over his final two games to vault into third place heading into the semifinals. He won all three of his semifinal matches to earn the second seed for the finals.

There were 47 entries in the third tournament of the 2013 – 2014 season. Zachary Doty of Nassau earned a \$60 scholarship for finishing fifth; Corey Buckley won a \$50 scholarship for finishing sixth; Andrew Marotta of Ballston Spa won a \$40 scholarship for finishing seventh; Jacob Rivers Jr. of Albany won a \$35 scholarship for finishing eighth; Anthony Ranere of Ballston Spa and James Brown of Albany each won \$30 scholarships for finishing ninth and tenth, respectively. A total of \$1,065 in scholarships was awarded to our talented youth bowlers, bringing the season total to \$2,905.

Our next tournament will be held at 1:30 pm on Saturday, November 23rd at Sportsmans Bowl. It will also offer optional Junior Gold qualifying for all current CDYST members who competed in at least one tournament this season. 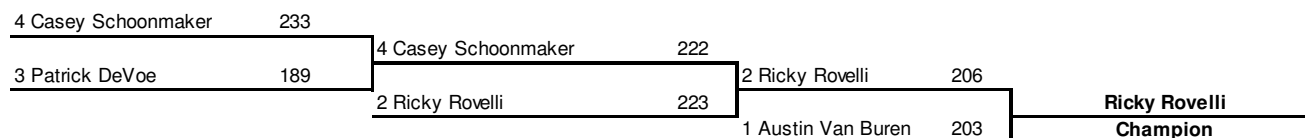
