

2012 Hometown Lanes Tournament Wrap-up

Vernon Billington II of Hartford, CT outscored tournament leader Corey Buckley of Albany 279 – 258 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Hometown Lanes on Saturday, November 10th.

The stepladder finals began with the fourth-seeded Casey Schoonmaker of Albany defeating third-seeded Justin Carl of Albany 258 - 214. Carl earned an \$85 scholarship for finishing fourth. The second-seeded Billington II defeated Schoonmaker 258 - 207 to set up the title match. Schoonmaker earned a \$130 scholarship for finishing third.

In an exciting championship match, both bowlers rolled eight strikes in the first nine frames, with solid 10-pins spoiling their bids for perfection. Buckley had begun with the first four strikes, while Billington II started with the first seven. Billington II finished with three strikes in the tenth frame to force Buckley to match him in order to tie. Buckley left a 9-pin on the first ball in the tenth frame, enabling Billington II to win his first CDYST title and a \$300 scholarship. Buckley earned a \$185 scholarship for his runner-up finish.

In a highly competitive tournament, Billington II led a tightly-packed field after the four-game qualifying round. The top six bowlers were separated by 16 pins and there was a spread of only 96 pins between the 14 semifinalists, with a potential 90 bonus pins available for match game wins. Buckley rolled a 706 3-game series and won two matches to earn the top seed for the finals; Billington II won all three of his matches to claim the second seed; Carl won two matches to qualify third. In the seventh game, Gazmine Mason of Cranston, RI rolled a 279 game to vault from seventh place into a tie for fourth with Schoonmaker. Schoonmaker defeated her 49 – 28 in a two-frame rolloff to earn the fourth seed.

A record 41 bowlers competed in the third of ten 2012 – 2013 regular season tournaments. Mason earned a \$55 scholarship for finishing fifth; Zachary Doty of Nassau won a \$45 scholarship for finishing sixth; Christopher Hanson of Ballston Lake won a \$40 scholarship for finishing seventh; Ricky Rovelli of Albany earned a \$35 scholarship for finishing eighth; Jacob Rivers Jr. of Albany and Qwadarus Rembert of Providence, RI each won a \$30 scholarships for finishing ninth and tenth, respectively. A regular season tournament record \$1,085 in scholarships was awarded to our talented youth bowlers, bringing the season total to \$2,980.
