

November 2014 Hometown Lanes Tournament Wrap-up

Jonathan Bowman of Peru defeated tournament leader Casey Schoonmaker 213 – 173 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Hometown Lanes on Saturday, November 22nd.

The stepladder finals began with fourth-seeded Christopher Kokes of Mooers defeating thirdseeded Kenny Livengood of Ravena 198 – 186. Livengood won a \$75 scholarship for finishing fourth in the Boys Division. The second-seeded Bowman then defeated Kokes 224 – 166 to set up the title match. Kokes earned a \$100 scholarship for finishing third in the Boys Division.

The title match began with Schoonmaker holding an early 8-pin lead. Bowman responded with four consecutive marks to take an 11-pin lead through five frames. He then rolled four consecutive strikes in the sixth through ninth frames to pull away and earn his record-tying sixth CDYST title and a \$250 scholarship as the top finisher in the Boys Division. Schoonmaker earned a \$150 scholarship for his runner-up finish.

In the qualifying round, Amanda Chrzanowski of Schenectady led following the first three games. Livengood then rolled a 266 in his final game to earn first place heading into the semifinals. He would retain the lead following victories in each of his first two semifinal matches. However, Schoonmaker rolled a 256 in Game 7 to win his second consecutive match and surge into the top spot heading into the finals. Bowman won two of his three matches to qualify second; while Livengood earned the third seed. Kokes won all three of his matches to round out the top four.

There were 51 entries in the fourth tournament of the 2014 – 2015 season; 35 in the Boys Division and 16 in the Girls Division. Additional scholarship winners in the Boys Division included: Andrew Bennett of Albany (\$50) in fifth place; Chad Sutliff of Valatie and Zack Terry of Schenectady (\$35 each) tied for sixth. Scholarship winners in the Girls Division are as follows: Jordan Byrnes of Kinderhook (\$150) for finishing first (10th overall); Chrzanowski (\$90) in second (15th overall); Tiera Gulum of Schenectady (\$60) in third (23rd overall); and Janelle Irwin of Schenectady (\$30) in fourth (25th overall). A total of \$1,190 in scholarships was awarded to our talented youth bowlers, bringing the season total to \$4,645.

Our next tournament will begin at 1:00 pm on Saturday, December 13th at Imperial Lanes in Amsterdam. It is open to all youth bowlers and will also offer optional Junior Gold qualifying for any 2014 – 2015 CDYST member who has competed in at least one prior tournament this season.
