2016 Hometown Lanes Tournament Wrap-up

Tom Hankey of Great Barrington, MA defeated Andrew Hall of Westborough, MA 277 – 237 in the position round match to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Hometown Lanes on Saturday, March 19th.

Sarah Gill of Attleboro, MA began her day with a 257 to take the lead following Game 1 of the qualifying round. Hall then began Game 2 with 11 consecutive strikes before leaving a 10-pin to roll the second 299 game in CDYST history and pull ahead. He would remain on top through the remainder of the round. His 951 four-game series is the seventh highest ever in a CDYST event.

Employing a modified format without a stepladder final, the bowlers rolled three match games; with the final match as a position round. Hankey rolled a 276 in winning his first match to close to within eight pins of Hall's lead; Hunter Kempton of Buzzard's Bay rolled a 279 to move into third and Brandon Wolf of Schenectady rolling a 255 to rise into fourth. Hall and Hankey each won their second consecutive matches to pull away from the rest of the field by over 100 pins; with Hall leading Hankey by 39 pins and setting up a position round match between the two bowlers.

Hankey began the position round match with six consecutive strikes to take a 20-pin lead. Following a spare, he rolled four more strikes to win the match and earn the 30-pin bonus. The seven-game totals showed Hankey moving ahead of Hall by 31 pins to win his first CDYST title and a \$275 scholarship as the top bowler in the Boys Division. Hall won a \$175 scholarship for his runner-up finish. Hankey's totals of 1,667 and 1,757 with bonus are both the second highest in CDYST history. Hall's totals of 1,666 and 1,726 with bonus are the third and fourth highest, respectively. Zachery Porter of Schenectady won his position round match to finish third and earn a \$100 scholarship; Jonathan Bowman of Peru rolled a 280 in his position round match to rise from seventh place and finish fourth; earning an \$80 scholarship.

A field of 59 bowlers (39 boys and 20 girls) competed in our 11th tournament of the season and earned \$1,400 in scholarships; bringing the season total to \$15,225.

Additional scholarship winners in the Boys Division are as follows: Justin Carl of Albany (\$60) in fifth place; Brandon Wolf of Schenectady (\$50) in sixth; Hunter Kempton of Buzzard's Bay, MA (\$40) in seventh; and Zack Terry of Schenectady (\$35) in eighth (ninth overall). Scholarship winners in the Girls Division are as follows: Gill (\$175) in first place (eighth overall); Jenna Lemke of Delmar (\$125) in second (tenth overall); Rachel Bamford of Rochester, NH (\$75) in third (14th overall); and Jordan Byrnes of Kinderhook (\$50) in fourth (22nd overall).

Our next tournament will begin at 1:00 pm on Saturday April 9, 2016 at East Greenbush Bowling Center. It is our final open tournament of the season and it will also offer optional Junior Gold qualifying for any 2015 – 2016 CDYST members who have competed in at least three prior tournaments this season.
