



2014 Imperial Lanes Tournament Wrap-up

Jonathan Bowman of Peru capped off a nearly wire-to-wire victory by defeating Chad Sutliff of Valatie 190 - 176 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Imperial Lanes on Saturday, January 25th.

The stepladder finals began with the third-seeded Sutliff edging fourth-seeded Ricky Rovelli of Albany 215 - 211. Rovelli earned an \$85 scholarship for finishing fourth. Sutliff then rolled the last seven strikes to defeat the second-seeded Austin Van Buren of Altamont 266 - 225 and set up the title match. Van Buren earned a \$125 scholarship for finishing third.

Both bowlers started off slowly in championship match with Bowman holding a one pin lead through three frames. Strikes in the fourth and fifth frames enabled him to extend it to 21 pins. Both bowlers marked in frames six through eight, but an open in the ninth frame by Bowman reduced his lead to 8 pins. However, he responded with two strikes in the tenth frame to win his third CDYST title of the season - fourth overall - and a \$275 scholarship. Sutliff earned a \$175 scholarship for his runner-up finish.

Competing in an extended six-game qualifying round on the WTBA Tokyo lane condition, Bowman was in third place following Game 1. However, he took the lead by one pin after Game 2 and then took charge by rolling the fifth 300 game in CDYST competition during Game 3. His lead was 66 pins following the qualifying round and he extended it to 190 pins by winning two of his three semifinal matches. Sutliff was in 17th place after two games, but he rolled 704 from Games 3 through 5 to move into third. Two victories in the semifinals enabled him to remain there heading into the finals. Van Buren was in ninth place following the qualifying round; he won all three of his semifinal matches to earn the second seed.

There were 40 entries in the eighth tournament of the season. Christopher Radliff of Schenectady won a \$60 scholarship for finishing fifth; Justin Carl of Albany won a \$50 scholarship for finishing sixth; Jay Hadcock of Johnstown won a \$40 scholarship for finishing seventh; and Billy McGaffin of Amsterdam won a \$35 scholarship for finishing eighth. Our talented youth bowlers earned \$955 in scholarships, bringing the season total to \$9,470. Radliff, Sutliff, and Amanda LaBelle of Pattersonville earned entries into the 2014 USBC Junior Gold Championships to be held from July 12 - 18, 2014 in Buffalo, New York.

Our next tournament will begin at 12:30 pm on Saturday, February 8th at Uncle Sam Lanes in Troy. It will also offer optional Junior Gold qualifying for all current CDYST members who competed in at least two tournaments this season.
