## 2015 Imperial Lanes Tournament Wrap-up

Christopher Radliff of Schenectady defeated Tom Hankey of Great Barrington, MA 240 – 208 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Imperial Lanes on Saturday, December 12th.

The stepladder finals began with the fourth-seeded Hankey defeating third-seeded Justin Carl of Albany 242 – 201. Carl won a \$75 scholarship for finishing fourth in the Boys Division. Hankey then defeated second-seeded Corey Hommel of Clifton Park 277 – 221 to set up the title match. Hommel earned a \$100 scholarship for finishing third in the Boys Division.

Both bowlers began the championship match with two strikes followed by two spares; with Radliff edging ahead by four pins. Two more spares enabled him to expand the lead to 12 pins. He then rolled five consecutive strikes to pull away and win his second career CDYST title (second of the season) and a \$225 scholarship as the top finisher in the Boys division. Hankey earned a \$125 scholarship for his runner-up finish.

Competing in a six-game qualifying round on the WTBA Tokyo sport-compliant lane condition, Mariah Williams of Bloomington led following Game 1. Thomas Mains of Port Ewen then took the lead following a 277 in Game 2 and would remain on top after Game 3. Peter Konrad was the leader after Games 4 and 5 before Radliff rolled a 276 to rise from fifth place into the lead heading into the semifinals. Also in Game 6, Hommel rolled a spare followed by the last 11 strikes for a 290 to vault from 16th into fourth place heading into the semifinals.

In the semifinals, Radliff won two of his three of his semifinal matches to earn the top seed for the finals. Hommel and Carl each won all three of their matches to become the second and third seeds, respectively. Hankey won two matches, including a 279 in his final game to vault from seventh place into fourth and earn the last spot in the finals.

A total of 54 bowlers (31 boys and 23 girls) competed in the fifth tournament of the season. The scholarship winners in the Girls Division were Britaney Myers of Mechanicville (\$200) in first place (fifth overall); Williams (\$125) in second (seventh overall); Jordan Byrnes of Kinderhook (\$75) in third (15th overall); Jenna Lemke of Delmar (\$50) in fourth (18th overall); and Janelle Irwin of Schenectady in fifth (19th overall). The remaining scholarship winners in the Boys Division are as follows: Zack Terry of Schenectady (\$50) in fifth place (sixth overall); Peter Konrad of Schenectady (\$45) in sixth (eighth overall); and Kenny Livengood of Ravena (\$40) in seventh (ninth overall). Our talented youth bowlers earned \$1,295 in scholarships; bringing the season total to \$6,005.

Radliff, Hommel, Terry, Williams, Myers, Byrnes and Lemke earned entries into the 2016 USBC Junior Gold Championships to be held in Indianapolis, Indiana.

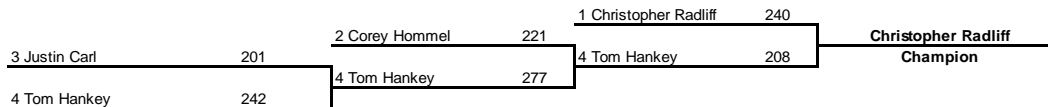
