February 2016 Imperial Lanes Tournament Wrap-up

Zack Terry of Schenectady won three matches in the stepladder finals, including a 192 – 187 victory over Andrew Hall of Westborough, MA to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Imperial Lanes on Saturday, February 27th.

The stepladder finals began with the fourth-seeded Terry defeating third-seeded Kenny Livengood of Ravena 204 – 164. Livengood won a \$75 scholarship for finishing fourth in the Boys Division. Terry then filled 20 pins in the tenth frame to edge second-seeded Christopher Radliff of Schenectady 196 – 195 and set up the title match. Radliff earned a \$100 scholarship for finishing third in the Boys Division.

In a very competitive title match, Terry took a 15-pin lead through three frames. However, by the fifth frame, Hall had reduced his deficit to two pins; before rolling consecutive strikes to take a seven-pin lead. Terry responded by rolling three consecutive strikes in the eighth through tenth frames to take a three-pin lead and withstand consecutive strikes by Hall in the ninth and tenth frames to earn his second title of the season (second career) and a \$275 scholarship as the top finisher in the Boys division. Hall earned a \$150 scholarship for his runner-up finish.

Competing in a six-game qualifying round on the WTBA Beijing sport-compliant lane condition, Terry jumped out to the lead following Game 1. Livengood rolled a 256 in Game 2 to become the leader. He remained on top through the remainder of the qualifying round. During Game 3, one bowler knocked down the 3,000,000th pin in CDYST history.

In the semifinals, Radliff took the lead following a victory in his first match. Hall then rose to the top following his second consecutive victory in Game 8. Victories by Hall and Radliff in their third matches enabled them to earn the top two respective seeds for the finals. Livengood and Terry each won two semifinal matches to become the third and fourth seeds.

A total of 49 bowlers (37 boys and 12 girls) competed in the tenth tournament of the season. The remaining scholarship winners in the Boys Division are as follows: Brandon Wolf of Schenectady (\$50) in fifth place; Christopher Kokes of Mooers (\$45) in sixth; Hunter Kempton of Buzzard's Bay, MA (\$40) in seventh (eighth overall); and Christian Baitinger of Greenfield Center (\$40) in eighth (twelfth overall). In the Girls Division, Jenna Lemke of Delmar finished first and won a \$125 scholarship; Britaney Myers of Mechanicville and Mariah Williams of Bloomington finished tied for second (ninth overall) and earned \$62.50 scholarships. Our talented youth bowlers earned \$1,120 in scholarships; bringing the season total to \$13,825.

Kokes, Wolf, Rebecca LaBelle of Pattersonville, and siblings Dominick and Julia Favata of Niskayuna earned entries into the 2016 USBC Junior Gold Championships to be held in Indianapolis, Indiana. This establishes a new CDYST record as 31 bowlers have now advanced to Junior Gold through CDYST events this season.

Our next two tournaments will be held on Saturday and Sunday March 19th and 20th. The tournament on Saturday will be a regular format event starting at 12:30 pm at Hometown Lanes in Mechanicville. It is open to any USBC-certified youth bowler. The following day, our tour heads to Barbecue Recreation in Hoosick Falls for a special event where the top four bowlers after four games of qualifying will advance to a stepladder finals that will be televised as part of the Huck Finn's Capital Region Bowling Show. Due to space and time constraints, this event is open to the first 40 CDYST members who reserve their spot with a fully-paid entry.

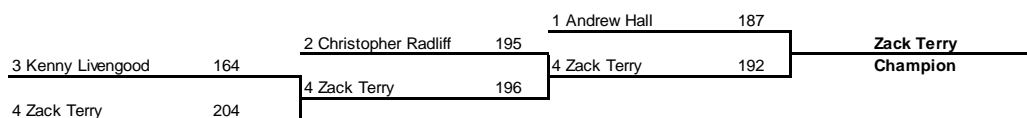
