



## 2015 Kingpin's Alley Tournament Wrap-up

Justin Carl of Albany defeated Hunter Kempton of Buzzard's Bay, MA 182 – 125 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Kingpin's Alley on Saturday, October 17th.

The stepladder finals began with the third-seeded Kempton defeating fourth-seeded Patrick Hoey of Latham 212 – 194. Hoey won a \$75 scholarship for finishing fourth in the Boys Division. Kempton then defeated second-seeded Nick Pondillo of Troy 181 – 162 to set up the title match. Pondillo earned a \$100 scholarship for finishing third in the Boys Division.

Carl began the championship match with two strikes in the first three frames to take a 12-pin lead. Following spares in the fifth through seventh frames, he rolled strikes in the eighth and ninth frames clinch his fifth career title and earn a \$250 scholarship as the top finisher in the Boys division. Kempton earned a \$150 scholarship for his runner-up finish.

Competing in a six-game qualifying round on the WTBA Montreal sport-compliant lane condition, Pondillo led following Game 1. Spencer Catlin of Diamond Point then led the field after Games 2 and 3 before Hoey rose to the top following Game 4. Carl then surged ahead following a 253 in Game 5 and a 257 in Game 6 to take a 59 pin lead heading into the semifinals. He won all three of his semifinal matches to extend the lead to 146 pins and earn the top seed for the finals. Pondillo and Kempton each won two of their three matches to earn the second and third seeds, respectively. Hoey won one match to become the fourth finalist.

A total of 50 bowlers (34 boys and 16 girls) competed in the second tournament of the season. The remaining scholarship winners in the Boys Division are as follows: Andrew Marotta of Ballston Spa (\$50) in fifth place; Tom Hankey of Great Barrington, MA (\$45) in sixth (seventh overall); and Jay Hadcock of Johnstown (\$40) in seventh (eighth overall). The scholarship winners in the Girls Division were Katie Lynch of Troy (\$150) in first place (sixth overall); Janelle Irwin of Schenectady (\$90) in second (tenth overall); Amanda Chrzanowski of Schenectady (\$60) in third (twelfth overall); and Morgan Ruggeri of Johnstown (\$40) in fourth (19th overall). Our talented youth bowlers earned \$1,180 in scholarships; bringing the season total to \$2,290

Lynch, Irwin, Chrzanowski, Carl, Pondillo, Hadcock, and Michael Boyce of Schuylerville earned entries into the 2016 USBC Junior Gold Championships to be held in Indianapolis, Indiana.

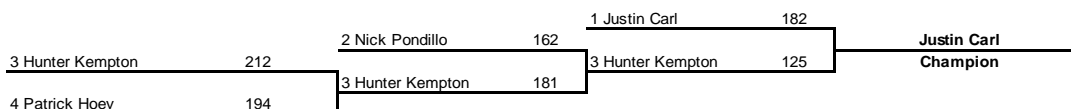
