

2012 Ferraro's Mid-City Lanes Tournament Wrap-up

Christopher Hanson of Ballston Lake defeated Zachary Doty of Nassau 246 – 236 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Ferraro's Mid-City Lanes in Kingston on Saturday, February 18th.

The stepladder finals began with the third-seeded Michael Hartmann of Earlton defeating fourth-seeded Austin Van Buren of Altamont 198 – 184. Van Buren earned a \$70 scholarship for finishing fourth. The second-seeded Hanson then rolled the first eight strikes to defeat Hartmann 269 – 167 and set up the title match. Hartmann earned a \$100 scholarship for finishing third.

In the championship match, Hanson rolled the first four strikes to jump out to a 31-pin lead. Doty countered with strikes in the third through seventh frames to cut the lead to 9 pins. Being the first bowler to finish, Doty rolled the last four strikes, forcing Hanson to fill 20 pins in the tenth frame for the win. Hanson struck on his first ball and followed with a spare to win his CDYST record-tying third title and a \$250 scholarship. Doty earned a \$140 scholarship for his second place finish.

In a tournament marked by several high scores, four different bowlers led after each game of the qualifying round; Doty rolled 706 over his last three games to earn the top spot heading into the semifinals. Anthony Alix of Watervliet began the semifinal round with a 247 game and Hanson rolled 289 to move into the top two spots; Doty replied with 279 and 255 in Games 6 and 7 to retake the lead and earn the top seed heading to the finals.

There were 25 entries in the eighth of ten tournaments during the 2011 – 2012 season. Alix earned a \$40 scholarship for finishing fifth; Nicholas Peckowitz of Altamont and Casey Schoonmaker of Albany finished tied for sixth and each earned a \$15 scholarship. A total of \$745 in scholarships was awarded to our talented youth bowlers, bringing the season total to \$6,955.
