

November 2010 Tournament Wrap-up

Stephen LaMalfa of Scotia defeated Ricky Rovelli of Albany 213 – 180 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Uncle Sam Lanes on Saturday, November 20th. LaMalfa was in sixth place following the qualifying round and fired a 263 in the first game of the semifinals to vault into second place. A victory in his third semifinal match enabled him to earn the top seed for the stepladder finals.

Rovelli, who qualified third, was locked in on the championship pair. He began the finals with a 220 – 170 victory over Kalynn Carl of Albany and followed by tossing the first six strikes in a 231 – 160 win over Chris Hanson of Ballston Lake. Carl and Hanson earned \$30 and \$50 scholarships for finishing fourth and third, respectively. In the title match, however, LaMalfa jumped out to an early lead. Rovelli was able to stay close, but he opened in the 7th frame; LaMalfa followed with a key triple to pull away and win his first CDYST title and \$150 scholarship prize. Rovelli earned a \$90 scholarship for his runner-up finish.

In an event marked by some of the highest scores of the season, Carl assumed the early lead with a 257 opening game and remained there until Shane Bartnicki of Niskayuna shot 249 in Game 4 to earn the top spot heading into the semifinals. During the semifinals, the conclusion of each game saw a different leader; of note, Anthony Alix of Watervliet bowled the highest game of the season with a 278 in Game 5.

In the third of eight monthly CDYST tournaments, there were 19 entries. The next event will be held at Redwood Lanes on Saturday, December 11th at 1:30 PM.
