## **September 2010 Tournament Wrap-up**

Chris Hanson of Ballston Lake defeated Dillon Davis of West Coxsackie 223 – 160 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held Saturday September 25<sup>th</sup> at Del Lanes. In the qualifying round, which saw a different leader after each of the first three games, Hanson emerged as the front-runner with a 241 in the fourth and final game. He held the lead until the third and final game of the semifinals, where Davis defeated him 214 – 191. Davis earned a 30-pin bonus for the victory and was able to tie Hanson for the tournament lead at +87. Davis then won a two-frame roll-off 56 – 37 to claim the top seed for the stepladder finals.

In the finals, Stephen LaMalfa of Scotia defeated Ricky Rovelli of Albany 181 – 178 in a closely contested first match; Rovelli earned a \$30 scholarship for his fourth place finish. Hanson then defeated LaMalfa 238 – 154 to set up another match with Davis. In the title match, Davis converted the 6-7-9 and 3-6-7-9 splits early, but Hanson was able to pull away for his first CDYST title and a \$120 scholarship; Davis earned a \$65 scholarship for his runner-up performance. LaMalfa earned a \$40 scholarship for finishing third.

In the first of eight monthly tournaments for the CDYST, there were 15 entries. Theresa Shufelt of Watervliet bowled the highest game of the day with a 256. The next tournament will be held at Sportsman's Bowl on Saturday, October 16<sup>th</sup> at 2 PM.
