



2013 Spare Time Latham Tournament Wrap-up

Qwadaris Rembert of Providence, RI defeated tournament leader Vernon Billington II of Hartford, CT 211 - 191 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Spare Time Latham on Saturday, September 28th.

The stepladder finals began with fourth-seeded Jadee Scott-Jones of East Providence, RI defeating third-seeded Patrick DeVoe of Delmar 193 - 175. DeVoe earned a \$75 scholarship for finishing fourth. The second-seeded Rembert then defeated Scott-Jones 230 - 189 to set up the title match. Scott-Jones earned a \$100 scholarship for finishing third.

Billington began the title match with two strikes to jump out to a 23-pin lead. Rembert responded with four strikes in the next five frames to take a 20-pin lead through seven frames. Needing a mark in the tenth frame, Rembert rolled three strikes to win his first CDYST title and a \$275 scholarship. Billington earned a \$150 scholarship for his second place finish.

Rembert began the day with the first nine strikes in rolling a 266 to take a lead that he would retain throughout the qualifying round. He won his first two semifinal matches to remain in the lead through six games. However, Billington won all three of his matches to pass Rembert following the seventh game and earn the top seed heading into the finals.

There were 38 entries in the opening tournament of the 2013 - 2014 season. Zachery Porter of Schenectady earned a \$55 scholarship for finishing fifth; Zachary Doty of Nassau won a \$40 scholarship for finishing sixth; Christopher Radliff of Schenectady and Jacob Rivers Jr. of Albany tied for seventh and each won \$32.50. A total of \$870 in scholarships was awarded to our talented youth bowlers.
