



2014 Spare Time Latham Tournament Wrap-up

Joseph Mains of Port Ewen defeated tournament leader Patrick Hoey of Latham 167 – 160 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Spare Time Latham on Saturday, September 27th.

The stepladder finals began with third-seeded Andrew Marotta of Ballston Spa defeating fourth-seeded Justin Carl of Albany 188 – 145. Carl earned a \$60 scholarship for finishing fourth in the Boys Division. The second-seeded Mains then rolled a strike on his first ball in the tenth frame to edge Marotta 189 – 186 and set up the title match. Marotta earned a \$90 scholarship for finishing third in the Boys Division.

In the title match, Mains jumped out to a quick 22-pin lead following strikes in the second through fourth frames. Hoey responded with five consecutive marks in the third through seventh frames to chip away at the deficit and take a three-pin lead. However, Mains rolled two strikes in the tenth frame to earn his first CDYST title and a \$250 scholarship as the top finisher in the Boys Division. Hoey earned a \$140 scholarship for finishing second.

In a competitive qualifying round, Jonathan Bowman of Peru, Morgan Ruggeri of Johnstown, and Mains were the respective leaders following the first three games. Ruggeri, Mains, and Patrick DeVoe of Delmar all finished as co-leaders heading into the semifinals. Hoey rolled a 663 three-game series and won all of his semifinal matches to surge from sixth place into the lead heading into the finals. Mains and Marotta were also undefeated as they earned the second and third seeds, respectively. Carl won two of his three matches to round out the top four.

There were 46 entries in the opening tournament of the 2014 – 2015 season; 30 in the Boys Division and 16 in the Girls Division. Additional scholarship winners in the Boys Division included: Bowman (\$40) for finishing fifth and AJ Indovina of Albany (\$30) in sixth. The scholarship winners in the Girls Division are as follows: Ruggeri (\$150) for finishing first (9th overall); Erika Bollock of Schenectady (\$80) in second (12th overall); Katie Lynch of Troy (\$50) in third (13th overall); and Sarah Gill of Attleboro, MA (\$30) in fourth (14th overall). A total of \$1,045 in scholarships was awarded to our talented youth bowlers.
