



2015 Spare Time Latham Tournament Wrap-up

Andrew Hall of Westborough, MA defeated tournament leader Justin Carl of Albany 234 – 169 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Spare Time Latham on Saturday, September 26th.

The stepladder finals began with the third-seeded Jeh'ron Cherry of Albany rolling a strike on his first ball in the tenth frame to edge Patrick Hoey of Latham 179 – 171. Hoey won a \$75 scholarship for finishing fourth in the Boys Division. The second-seeded Hall then defeated Cherry 161 – 146 to advance to the title match. Cherry earned a \$100 scholarship for finishing third in the Boys Division.

In the championship match, both bowlers began with marks in the first four frames. However, Hall was leading by 11 pins. He then rolled six consecutive strikes in the sixth through tenth frames to pull away for his first career title and a \$225 scholarship as the top finisher in the Boys Division. Carl won a \$125 scholarship for his runner-up finish.

In a qualifying round that saw four different leaders, Mariah Williams of Bloomington led after Game 1. Garrett Bartlett of Troy rolled a 267 in Game 2 to surge ahead. Hall took the lead following a 267 of his own in Game 3. However, Carl vaulted ahead after Game 4 to become the leader heading into the semifinals. Carl then rolled a 679 three-game series and won each of his matches to increase his lead and earn the top seed for the finals. Hall was also undefeated and rolled a 255 in Game 7 to earn the second seed. Cherry won two of his three matches to become the third seed. Hoey and Bartlett each won two matches as well and finished tied for fourth place. Hoey then defeated Bartlett 47 – 17 in a two-frame rolloff to advance to the finals.

A field of 47 bowlers (32 boys and 15 girls) competed in our opening tournament of the season and earned \$1,110 in scholarships.

Additional scholarship winners in the Boys Division are as follows: Bartlett (\$55) in fifth place; Jahlil Young of Albany (\$45) in sixth (ninth overall); and Christopher Kokes (\$35) in seventh (tenth overall). The Girls Division scholarship winners are as follows: Haley Groat of Mechanicville (\$140) in first place (sixth overall); Megan Lambert of Queensbury (\$90) in second (seventh overall); Jordan Byrnes of Kinderhook (\$50) in third (eighth overall); and Mariah Williams of Bloomington (\$35) in fourth (twelfth overall).

Our next tournament will begin at 1:00 pm on Saturday October 17, 2015 at Kingpin's Alley in South Glens Falls. It will also offer optional Junior Gold qualifying for all CDYST members. Bowlers may purchase their membership that day and still try and qualify.
