



2011 Sportsman's Bowl Tournament Wrap-up

Matthew Olson of Schenectady defeated Justin Carl of Albany 199 – 176 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Sportsman's Bowl on Saturday, November 19th.

The stepladder finals began with third-seeded Christopher Hanson of Ballston Lake defeating fourth-seeded Bethany Duchowny of Troy 230 – 190. Duchowny earned a \$70 scholarship for finishing fourth. The second-seeded Carl then defeated Hanson 186 - 160 to set up the title match. Hanson earned a \$100 scholarship for finishing third.

In the championship match, Olson rolled four strikes in the first five frames to take a 20-pin lead. Carl was able to close the gap to 10 pins; but Olson was up to the challenge as he pulled away to win his second CDYST title of the season and a \$250 scholarship. Carl earned a \$150 scholarship for his second place finish.

The bowlers competed in an extended six-game qualifying round that saw Carl and Olson flip-flop as the leader after Games 1 through 4. From that point on, Olson opened up a 224-pin lead after nine games to earn the top seed for the finals; Carl remained second and Hanson stayed within the top four for the remainder of the event. Duchowny was able to win her last two semifinal matches to rise from 10th place after seven games to earn the fourth seed for the finals.

In the fourth of ten tournaments in the 2011 – 2012 season, there was a record 32 entries. Anthony Alix of Watervliet won a \$50 scholarship for finishing fifth; Lawrence Lang of Rhinebeck earned a \$40 scholarship for finishing sixth; Casey Schoonmaker of Albany earned a \$35 scholarship for finishing seventh. A total of \$840 in scholarships was awarded to our talented youth bowlers, bringing the season total to \$2,405. Olson, Lang, and Amber Dominic of Latham earned berths into the USBC Junior Gold national tournament to be held in Indianapolis from July 14 – 20, 2012.
