2013 Sportsmans Bowl Tournament Wrap-up

Casey Schoonmaker of Albany won three matches in the stepladder finals, including a 197 – 195 victory over tournament leader Jonathan Bowman of Peru to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Sportsmans Bowl on Saturday, November 23rd.

The stepladder finals began with the third-seeded Schoonmaker defeating fourth-seeded Andrew Marotta of Ballston Spa 208 – 195. Marotta earned a \$90 scholarship for finishing fourth. Schoonmaker then defeated the second-seeded Jacob Rivers Jr. of Albany 197 – 190 to set up the title match. Rivers earned a \$125 scholarship for finishing third.

Bowman began the championship match with three strikes in the first five frames to open a 25-pin lead. Schoonmaker responded with strikes in the fifth through seventh frames to pull within seven pins. After Bowman completed his game first, Schoonmaker rolled two perfect strikes in the tenth frame and filled seven pins to win his second CDYST title and a \$325 scholarship. Bowman earned a \$175 scholarship for his runner-up finish.

Competing in an extended six-game qualifying round on the demanding WTBA Athens lane condition, Rivers led throughout much of the round. However, Marotta rolled an impressive 737 series over his final three games to surge into the lead heading into the semifinals. In the semifinals, Bowman rolled a 264 in his first match to vault into a lead that he would retain throughout the round to earn the top seed heading into the finals. Rivers and Schoonmaker also won two of their three semifinal matches to earn the second and third seeds, respectively.

In the fourth of ten 2013 – 2014 regular season tournaments there were 45 entries. Jovanni Scaccia of Schenectady won a \$65 scholarship for finishing fifth; Michael Hartmann of Earlton won a \$50 scholarship for finishing sixth; Austin Van Buren of Altamont won a \$45 scholarship for finishing seventh; Zachery Porter of Schenectady won a \$40 scholarship for finishing eighth; and Christopher Radliff of Schenectady won a \$35 scholarship for finishing ninth. Our talented youth bowlers earned \$1,100 in scholarships, bringing the season total to \$4,005. Rivers, Schoonmaker, Lawrence Lang of Rhinebeck, Haley Groat of Mechanicville, and Morgan Ruggeri of Johnstown all earned entries into the 2014 USBC Junior Gold Championships to be held from July 12 – 18, 2014 in Buffalo, New York.

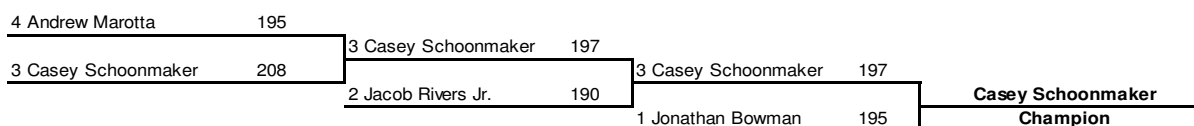
