November 2014 Sportsmans Bowl Tournament Wrap-up

Casey Schoonmaker of Albany defeated Billy McGaffin of Amsterdam 220 – 204 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Sportsmans Bowl on Saturday, November 8th.

The stepladder finals began with the third-seeded McGaffin striking in the sixth through tenth frames to erase a 25-pin deficit and defeat fourth-seeded Hunter Kempton of Buzzard's Bay, Massachusetts 226 – 214. Kempton won a \$75 scholarship for finishing fourth. McGaffin then defeated second-seeded Jonathan Bowman of Peru 227 – 141. Bowman earned a \$100 scholarship for finishing third.

McGaffin began the championship match with three strikes in the first four frames to take a quick 23-pin lead. Schoonmaker responded with six consecutive strikes in the fourth through ninth frames to surge to his fourth career CDYST title – third consecutive at Sportsmans Bowl – and a \$275 scholarship. McGaffin won a \$150 scholarship for finishing second.

Competing in an extended six-game qualifying round on the WTBA Tokyo lane condition, Haley Groat of Mechanicville led following Game 1. Schoonmaker took the lead after Game 2 and stretched it out to 106 pins heading into the semifinals. He won two of his three semifinal matches to retain the lead and earn the top seed heading into the finals. Bowman entered the semifinals in third place and also won two matches – including a 278 in his final match – to earn the second seed. McGaffin rolled a 247 in his final match for a second consecutive victory to vault from ninth place into third. Dominick Favata of Niskayuna and Hunter Kempton of Buzzard's Bay, Massachusetts began the semifinals in eighth and 14th places, respectively. Each bowler won all three of their matches to finish tied for fourth. Kempton then defeated Favata 36 – 28 in a two-frame roll-off to qualify for the finals as the fourth seed.

A total of 51 bowlers (35 boys and 16 girls) competed in the third tournament of the season. The remaining scholarship winners in the Boys Division were as follows: Dominick Favata (\$50) in fifth place; Zeph Kozakiewicz of Albany (\$40) in sixth; and Jeh'ron Cherry of Albany (\$35) in seventh. The scholarship winners in the Girls Division were Amanda Chrzanowski of Schenectady (\$150) in first place (13th overall); Morgan Ruggeri of Johnstown (\$90) in second (14th overall); Julia Favata of Niskayuna (\$60) in third (15th overall), and Mariah Williams of Bloomington (\$35) in fourth (17th overall). Our talented youth bowlers earned \$1,170 in scholarships, bringing the season total to \$3,455. Thomas Mains of Port Ewen, McGaffin, Dominick Favata, Chrzanowski, Williams, and Ruggeri each earned an entry into the 2015 USBC Junior Gold Championships to be held in Chicago, Illinois.

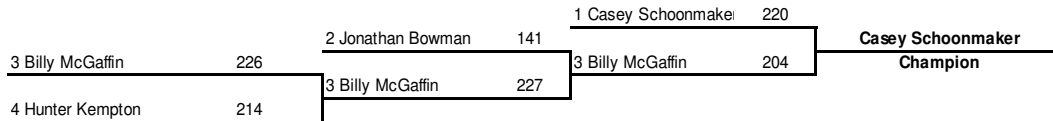
