March 2015 Sportsmans Bowl Tournament Wrap-up

Jonathan Bowman of Peru defeated Megan Lambert of Queensbury 225 – 202 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Sportmans Bowl on Saturday, March 14th.

The stepladder finals began with the third-seeded Lambert defeating fourth-seeded Brandon Wolf of Schenectady 186 – 166. Wolf won a \$100 scholarship for finishing third in the Boys Division (fourth overall). Lambert then defeated second-seeded Christopher Radliff of Schenectady 182 – 160. Radliff earned a \$150 scholarship for finishing second in the Boys Division (third overall).

Lambert began the championship match with five strikes in the first six frames to open up a 21-pin lead. Bowman responded with four consecutive strikes in the fifth through eighth frames to close the gap and take a 12-pin lead. He would finish with three more strikes in the tenth frame to become the first CDYST bowler to reach 10 titles. Bowman won a \$250 scholarship for his sixth victory of the season. Lambert finished second and earned a \$150 scholarship as the top finisher in the Girls Division.

Competing in a five-game qualifying round on the WTBA Los Angeles lane condition, Zach Terry of Schenectady led following Game 1. Bowman took the lead after Game 2 and stretched it out to 79 pins heading into the semifinals. He won all three of his semifinal matches to pull away and earn the top seed for the finals by 216 pins. Radliff and Lambert were second and third, respectively. Each won two of their semifinal matches to retain their positions into the finals. Wolf also won two matches to rise from eighth place after qualifying into fourth.

A total of 46 bowlers (32 boys and 14 girls) competed in the eleventh tournament of the season. The remaining scholarship winners in the Boys Division are as follows: Garrett Bartlett of Troy (\$75) in fourth place (fifth overall); Zack Terry of Schenectady (\$50) in fifth (sixth overall); Anthony Ranere of Ballston Spa (\$45) in sixth (seventh overall); Justin Bink of Albany (\$40) in seventh (11th overall); and Logan Brandt of Johnstown (\$35) in eighth (12th overall). The remaining scholarship winners in the Girls Division were Amanda Chrzanowski of Schenectady (\$90) in second place (8th overall); Jenna Lemke of Delmar (\$50) in third (ninth overall); and Britaney Myers of Mechanicville (\$35) in fourth (tenth overall). Our talented youth bowlers earned \$1,170 in scholarships; bringing the season total to \$14,565. Terry, Ranere, Brandt, Lambert, and Myers earned entries into the 2015 USBC Junior Gold Championships in Chicago, Illinois.

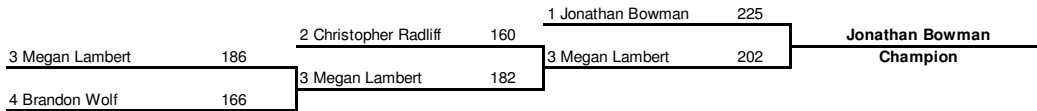
