## November 2015 Sportsmans Bowl Tournament Wrap-up

Hunter Kempton of Buzzard's Bay, MA won three matches in the stepladder finals; including a 223 – 162 victory over tournament leader Christopher Radliff of Schenectady to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Sportsmans Bowl on Saturday, November 21st.

The stepladder finals began with the third-seeded Kempton rolling six strikes in his first seven frames to defeat fourth-seeded Andrew Hall of Westborough, MA 236 – 180. Hall won a \$75 scholarship for finishing fourth in the Boys Division. Kempton then rolled strikes in the fourth through ninth frames in defeating second-seeded Kenny Livengood of Ravena 236 – 200 to advance to the title match. Livengood earned a \$100 scholarship for finishing third.

In the championship match, Kempton began with four strikes in his first five frames to open up a 43-pin lead. Following a spare in the sixth frame, he rolled three more strikes to pull away and earn his second career title and a \$250 scholarship as the top finisher in the Boys Division. Radliff won a \$150 scholarship for his runner-up finish.

In the qualifying round, Andrew Marotta of Ballston Spa jumped out to the lead following a 279 in Game 1; he led following Game 2, as well. Following a third consecutive strong game, Radliff surged ahead. However, Patrick Hoey of Latham rolled a 258 in his final game of qualifying to edge into the lead heading into the semifinals. In the semifinals, Radliff rolled a 692 three-game series and won two matches to earn the top seed for the finals. His seven game total pinfall (1,615) is the fifth highest seven-game series (without bonus) in CDYST history. Livengood won all three of his three matches to rise from seventh after qualifying into second place. Kempton won two matches to earn the third seed. Hall won all three of his matches to vault from tenth place after qualifying and into the fourth seed.

A field of 56 bowlers (34 boys and 22 girls) competed in our fourth tournament of the season and earned \$1,305 in scholarships; bringing the season total to \$4,710.

Additional scholarship winners in the Boys Division are as follows: Justin Carl of Albany (\$50) in fifth place; Brandon Wolf of Schenectady (\$40) in sixth; and Patrick Hoey of Latham (\$35) in seventh. Scholarship winners in the Girls Division scholarship winners are as follows Amanda Chrzanowski of Schenectady (\$175) in first place (ninth overall); Janelle Irwin of Schenectady (\$125) in second (11th overall); Mariah Williams of Bloomington (\$75) in third (12th overall); Morgan Ruggeri of Johnstown (\$50) in fourth (16th overall); and Lauren Piotrowski of Schenectady (\$35) in fifth (17th overall).

Our next tournament will begin at 1:00 pm on Saturday December 12, 2015 at Imperial Lanes in Amsterdam. It will also offer optional Junior Gold qualifying for any 2015 – 2016 CDYST member who has competed in at least one prior tournament this season.
