

2012 Sunset Lanes Tournament Wrap-up

Anthony Alix of Watervliet outscored Michael Hartmann of Earlton 266 – 257 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Sunset Lanes on Saturday, March 24th.

The stepladder finals began with the third-seeded Hartmann edging fourth-seeded Tyler Smith of Highland 203 – 198. Smith earned a \$70 scholarship for finishing fourth. Hartmann then followed up an open frame with nine consecutive strikes to defeat second-seeded Christopher Hanson of Ballston Lake 268 – 234 and set up the title match. Hanson earned a \$100 scholarship for finishing third.

In the highest scoring championship match in CDYST history, Alix rolled the first seven strikes. Hartmann countered with a spare and five strikes in a row to remain within 20 pins. After a spare in the eighth frame, Alix rolled the next two strikes to lock up his first CDYST title and a \$250 scholarship. Hartmann earned a \$140 scholarship for his second place finish.

In the qualifying round, Hanson jumped out quickly and held the lead after four games; Smith was second. Alix used a 3-0 semifinal match play record to overtake both bowlers and earn the top seed. Smith continued to perform steadily and Hartmann went 2-0-1 as both bowlers finished tied for third heading to the finals.

There were 27 entries in the ninth of ten regular season tournaments during the 2011 – 2012 season. Matthew Olson of Schenectady earned a \$45 scholarship for finishing fifth; Connor Chatterton of Clifton Park won a \$35 scholarship for finishing sixth; and Corey Buckley of Albany earned a \$30 scholarship for finishing seventh. A total of \$770 in scholarships was awarded to our talented youth bowlers, bringing the season total to \$7,725.

Our final regular season event of the season will be held at 2:00 pm on Saturday, April 14, 2012 at Towne Bowling Academy in Rotterdam.
