2013 Sunset Lanes Tournament Wrap-up

Justin Carl of Albany defeated Christopher Hanson of Ballston Lake 223 - 210 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Sunset Lanes on Saturday, February 9th.

The stepladder finals began with the third-seeded Chad Sutliff of Valatie defeating fourth-seeded Lawrence Lang of Rhinebeck 162 - 157. Lang earned a \$65 scholarship for finishing fourth. The second-seeded Hanson then defeated Sutliff 141 - 124 to set up the title match. Sutliff earned a \$90 scholarship for finishing third.

In a match between the bowlers who were in first and second place throughout the entire event, the top-seeded Carl rolled an early double to take a 10-pin lead. Hanson responded with a double of his own to close to within a pin after four frames. Carl then rolled four strikes in the next five frames to pull away and win his second CDYST title and a \$200 scholarship. Hanson earned a \$125 scholarship for his runner-up finish.

In the qualifying round, Carl jumped out to the early lead. Hanson then rolled the first 10 strikes in Game 2 to surpass Carl and maintain the lead throughout the qualifying round with a 950 four-game series. Carl won all three of his matches to regain the lead and earn the top seed heading into the finals. Sutliff and Lang posted 2 - 1 match play records to earn their respective berths into the finals.

A total of 23 bowlers competed in the eighth of ten 2012 - 2013 regular season tournaments. Michael Hartmann of Earlton earned a \$40 scholarship for finishing fifth and Christopher Radliff of Schenectady won a \$30 scholarship for finishing sixth. Our talented youth bowlers earned \$620 in scholarships, bringing the season total to \$9,898.

The next tournament will be held at 12:30 pm on Saturday, March 16th at Uncle Sam Lanes. This event will offer an extended qualifying round and optional Junior Gold qualifying for all CDYST members who have competed in at least three prior tournaments during the 2012 - 2013 season.
