

2012 Towne Bowling Academy Tournament Wrap-up

Corey Buckley set a seven-game scoring record of 1,658 and capped off a wire-towire victory by defeating Thomas Marr of Schenectady 254 – 157 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Towne Bowling Academy on Saturday, April 14th.

The stepladder finals began with the fourth-seeded Marr rolling three strikes in the tenth frame to edge third-seeded Michael Hartmann of Earlton 246 – 245. Hartmann earned a \$70 scholarship for finishing fourth. Marr then defeated second-seeded Christopher Radliff of Schenectady 173 – 165 to set up the title match. Radliff earned a \$100 scholarship for finishing third.

The top seeded Buckley rolled strikes in four of the first five frames to open up a 21pin lead. Following a spare in the sixth frame, he rolled five strikes in a row to earn his first CDYST title and a \$250 scholarship. Marr earned a \$140 scholarship for his second place finish.

Buckley began the day with a 233 game to take the early lead and never relinquished it. He finished the qualifying round with a 924 series. A 734 three-game series in the semifinals, along with a 3 – 0 match play record, enabled Buckley to open up a 234-pin lead. His seven-game total of 1,748 including bonus pins is also a new record. The title-match victory enabled him to become the first bowler to win a CDYST event after leading wire-to-wire.

There were 25 entries in the final regular season tournament of the 2011 – 2012 season. Lawrence Lang of Rhinebeck earned a \$40 scholarship for finishing fifth and Matthew Olson of Schenectady earned a \$30 scholarship for finishing sixth. A total of \$735 in scholarships was awarded to our talented youth bowlers, bringing the season total to \$8,460.

Our second season will conclude with the CDYST Masters on Saturday April 28th at Town 'n Country Lanes; the starting time is 9:30 am. This invitational event will offer a scholarship fund that exceeds \$2,000 and is only open to CDYST members who have competed in four or more tournaments during the 2011 – 2012 season. An optional Junior Gold qualifier will also be offered.
