



February 2015 Towne Bowling Academy Tournament Wrap-up

Christopher Hanson of Ballston Lake won three matches in the finals, including a 202 – 198 victory over Jonathan Bowman of Peru, to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Towne Bowling Academy on Saturday, February 28th.

The stepladder finals began with the fourth-seeded Hanson rolling strikes in the second through eighth frames to defeat Dominick Favata of Niskayuna 254 – 193. Favata won a \$75 scholarship for finishing fourth in the Boys Division. Hanson then defeated the second-seeded Justin Carl of Albany 245 – 188 to advance to the title match. Carl earned a \$100 scholarship for finishing third in the Boys Division.

In a championship match that was very close throughout, Hanson converted the 6-7-10 split in the third frame to retain a nine-pin lead. Bowman rolled strikes in the fourth and fifth frames to tie the match. Hanson responded with strikes in the fifth and sixth frames to regain his lead. With both bowlers continuing to fill frames, Bowman finished with two strikes in the tenth frame to force Hanson to get a mark in his tenth frame. Hanson converted the 3-6-10 and followed with a strike to earn his fifth career title and a \$250 scholarship as the top finisher in the Boys Division. Bowman won a \$150 scholarship for his runner-up finish.

In the qualifying round, Heather Aiken of Rensselaer began by rolling 236 and 235 to be the leader following the first two games. Carl led after Game 3 before Bowman surged ahead and finished with an 889 four-game series. Both Bowman and Carl won all three of their semifinal matches to pull away from the field and earn the top two seeds for the finals. Favata and Hanson each won two matches to vault from eighth and ninth, respectively, into third and fourth place.

A field of 51 bowlers (35 boys and 16 girls) competed in our tenth tournament of the season and earned \$1,150 in scholarships; bringing the season total to \$13,395.

Additional scholarship winners in the Boys Division are as follows: Zachery Porter of Schenectady (\$50) in fifth place; Andrew Marotta of Ballston Spa (\$40) in sixth; and Billy McGaffin of Amsterdam and Christopher Radliff of Schenectady (\$15 each) tied for seventh. The Girls Division scholarship winners are as follows: Aiken (\$150) in first place (6th overall); Tiera Gulum of Schenectady (\$90) in second (15th overall); Janelle Irwin (\$50) in third (19th overall); and Julia Favata of Niskayuna and Jessica Shufelt of Watervliet (\$15 each) tied for fourth (20th overall).

Our next tournament will begin at 1:30 pm on Saturday March 14, 2015 at Sportsmans Bowl in Schenectady. It will also offer optional Junior Gold qualifying for all CDYST members who have competed in at least three tournaments during the 2014 – 2015 season.
