

## 2014 Uncle Sam Lanes Tournament Wrap-up

Christopher Hanson of Ballston Lake defeated tournament leader Zachery Porter of Schenectady 232 - 128 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Uncle Sam Lanes on Saturday, February 8th.

The stepladder finals began with the third-seeded Justin Frey of Albany defeating fourth-seeded Zack Terry of Schenectady 204 - 169. Terry earned an \$85 scholarship for finishing fourth. The second-seeded Hanson then defeated Frey 244 - 213 to set up the title match. Frey earned a \$125 scholarship for finishing third.

Hanson began the championship match with five consecutive strikes to open up a 64-pin lead. Two spares followed by two more strikes enabled him to extend the lead and win his fourth CDYST title and a \$275 scholarship. Porter earned a \$175 scholarship for his runner-up finish.

Competing in an extended six-game qualifying round on the WTBA Seoul lane condition, Hanson jumped out to the early lead and remained there throughout the entire qualifying round. However, Porter defeated Hanson in their first semifinal match and followed up with another victory in his second match to surge into the lead after Game 8. He retained it following his final match to earn the top seed for the finals.

There were 41 entries in the eighth tournament of the season. Lawrence Lang of Rhinebeck won a \$60 scholarship for finishing fifth; Andrew Marotta of Ballston Spa won a \$50 scholarship for finishing sixth; Christopher Radliff of Schenectady won a \$40 scholarship for finishing seventh; and Billy McGaffin of Amsterdam and Haley Groat of Mechanicville each won \$35 scholarships for finishing eighth and ninth, respectively. Our talented youth bowlers earned \$980 in scholarships, bringing the season total to \$10,450. Hanson, Porter, Tiera Gulum of Schenectady and Amanda Chrzanowski of Schenectady earned entries into the 2014 USBC Junior Gold Championships to be held from July 12 - 18, 2014 in Buffalo, New York.

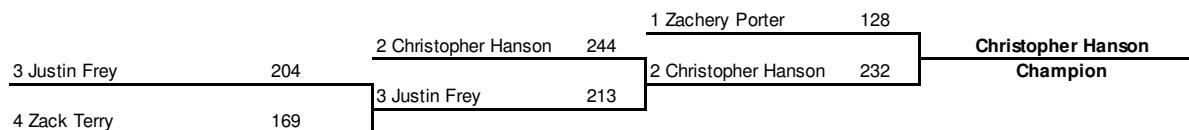
