



## 2016 Uncle Sam Lanes Tournament Wrap-up

Zack Terry of Schenectady capped off a wire-to-wire victory by defeating Jonathan Bowman of Peru 190 – 186 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Uncle Sam Lanes on Saturday, January 2nd.

The stepladder finals began with the fourth-seeded Brandon Indovina of Albany defeating third-seeded Andrew Marotta of Ballston Spa 203 – 146. Marotta won a \$75 scholarship for finishing fourth in the Boys Division. The second-seeded Bowman then rolled the last five strikes to defeat Indovina 230 – 161 and set up the title match. Indovina earned a \$100 scholarship for finishing third in the Boys Division.

In a title match indicative of the challenging lane conditions, neither bowler rolled consecutive strikes or had an open frame. Terry began with a strike followed by three spares; while Bowman started with two spares and a strike to take a two-pin lead. A strike by Terry in the fifth frame enabled him to take a one-pin lead. In the sixth, seventh, and eighth frames, Bowman converted the 2-5, 3-6-10, and 1-2-8 spares; and Terry picked up the 1-2-7, the 1-2, and the 2-4-8 to continue the clean match and expand his lead to three pins. Once Bowman finished his game with two more spares, Terry converted a four pin and followed with an eight count to win his first career title and a \$275 scholarship. Terry is also the first bowler to win wire-to-wire in a nine-game CDYST event; and third bowler ever. Bowman won a \$175 scholarship for his runner-up finish.

Competing in a six-game qualifying round on the WTBA Seoul sport-compliant lane condition, Terry began with a 265 in Game 1 to take a 30-pin lead. Over the next five games, he increased his lead to 47 pins heading into the semifinals. In the semifinals, Terry won the first of his three matches with a 257 game to extend the lead to 80 pins; with Bowman 112 pins behind in third place. Bowman, who also won three matches, rolled 266 and 244 in his final two games to close to within 10 pins of Terry and become the second seed for the finals. Marotta also won all three of his matches to earn the third seed. Indovina, who was in 16th place after qualifying, rolled a 257 in his final game to win his second match and rise from ninth place to become the fourth seed for the finals.

The second-highest turnout ever for a CDYST event – 63 bowlers (40 boys and 23 girls) – competed in the seventh tournament of the season. The scholarship winners in the Girls Division were Jordan Byrnes of Kinderhook (\$175) in first place (tied for fifth overall); Amanda Chrzanowski of Schenectady (\$125) in second (seventh overall); Kasey Kosier of East Greenbush (\$80) in third (ninth overall); Jenna Lemke of Delmar (\$50) in fourth (11th overall); and Tiera Gulum of Schenectady (\$40) in fifth (12th overall). The remaining scholarship winners in the Boys Division were Corey Hommel of Clifton Park (\$60) in fifth place (tied for fifth overall); Brandon Wolf of Schenectady (\$50) in sixth (eighth overall); Christopher Radliff of Schenectady (\$45) in seventh (tenth overall); and Jordan West of Cohoes (\$40) in eighth (14th overall). Our talented youth bowlers earned \$1,440 in scholarships; bringing the season total to \$9,900.

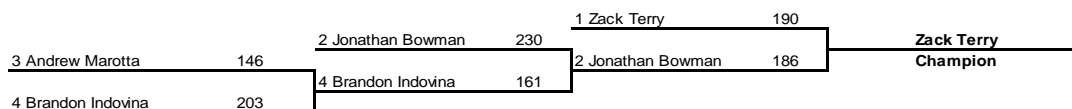
